Vine training method	Sustainable farming TERRA VITIS
Yield	50 hl/ha
Vine growing techniques	Density of plantation : 4 000 vine stocks/hectare Height of vegetation : 1,60 m Total height of the vines : 2,10 m Grassing between the rows Disbudding and thinning out of the leaves every year
Harvesting	Mechanical at optimal maturity
Wine making	Picking off and crushing the grapes Maceration for 15 days Analytical follow-up by an oenological laboratory
Maturing	Maturing in tank during 4 months Then 11 months of barrel 3 wines
Character	This old-vines displays an expressive nose of red berry fruit and woody, vanilla nuances The rich palate offers a juicy texture backed by soft and generous tannins
Keeping and serving advice	To be served within 5 years. Uncork in advance and serve at 16°-18°C
Food pairing	Poultry, red meats, game and cheese
